1 Lectures (Tentative)

1.1 Basic Internet Skills

Since this is first lecture a brief info about computers, Internet etc. and how to boot / login using Linux in workspace machines will be explained.

Then various browsers such as Internet Explorer, Firefox, etc. will be introduced. Concepts about proxy server and steps on how to configure proxy properly will be explained. How to browse websites, register, send / receive email will be explained. Information about popular free email service providers like Gmail / Yahoo etc. will be discussed. Information about SMTP / POP3 and email clients will be discussed.

Tips on using web search engines(Google) effectively will be given. Using instant messengers for chatting, web based messaging sites (meebo, coolim). Good websites like wikipedia, stackoverflow, w3schools, etc. will be introduced.

Basic security tips on good password, not to give personal information to untrusted sites, etc. Difference between HTTP and HTTPS and information on useful privacy plugins will be explained. Checking IP address of machine. What is URL? What DHCP and DNS servers?

Various intranet websites will also be introduced.

1.2 Filesystem and shell

Information about windows drives and Linux filesystem would be provided. Different units used to specify file size, hard-disk size, Internet bandwidth etc. will be discussed.

Concept of files and directories and directory sizes will be explained. Information about archive formats like zip, tar would be provided.

Students would be taught how to perform basic filesystem operations like cut, copy paste of files and folders using GUI. Then same skills will be taught using command line. Search, accessing other systems remotely, etc. will also be covered using command line.

1.3 vi editor

Information on how to use vi editor to edit text files will be provided. 'vimtutor' will be used as primary teaching tool and notes on vim would be provide for additional learning.

Some basic information on how to configure vim so that C, Java, etc. source files get indented as one types would also be provided.

1.4 Basic HTML

Following topics will be covered in Basic HTML

- Basic Tags: <html>, <head>, <body>, , <p>, <pre>,
 <hr>, , <a>, <u>, , <h1>, <sup>, <sub>
- HTML escape sequences: > < & "

- Text Input

- Submit button
